

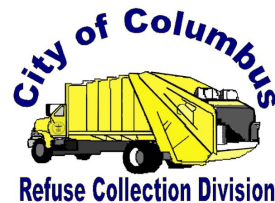

- 50% Reduction by 2030 and 90% Reduction by 2050 – 133,784 MT of GHG Impact

Reduce Recyclable Waste Sent to The Landfill

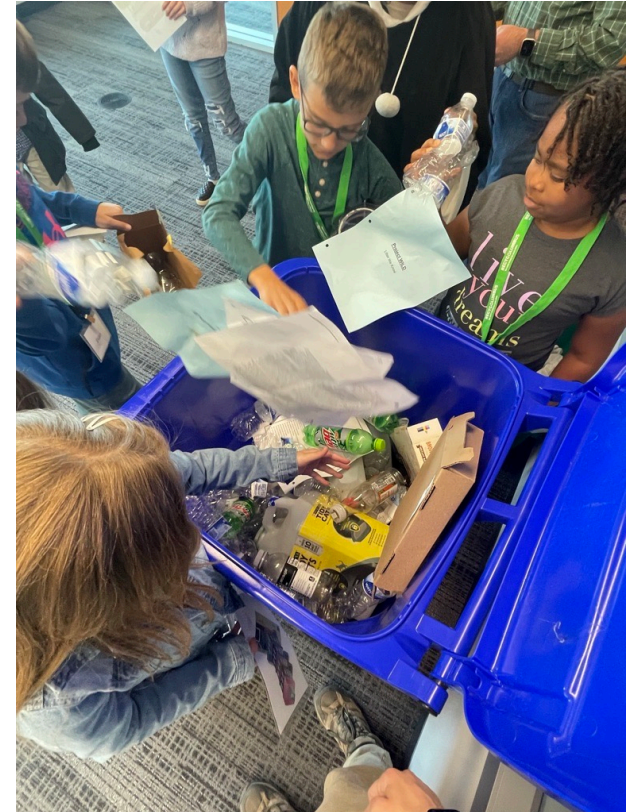
- 40% Reduction by 2030 and 95% Reduction by 2050 – 278,687 MT of GHG Impact
